

MINUTES
TOWN OF WAYNE PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING
Wayne Town Hall, 10/23/2013, 6:30p.m. – 7:00p.m.

1. Call to order – Carl Klemme
2. Pledge of Allegiance – led by Carl Klemme
3. Roll Call of Members: - All present, Gordon Hoffmann was in attendance.
4. Public notice: Shaske confirmed in the three designated public places and on the internet
5. Agenda – **MOTION**(Ellenbecker/Etta) to approve the agenda. Motion carried
6. Minutes – **MOTION** (Schulteis/Hesprich) to approve the September 18, 2013 – Planning Commission Minutes. Motion carried.
7. Visitors Comments/Concerns: Steve Schmitt commented on the rifle agenda item, suggesting the committee leave things as they are and not impose an ordinance.
8. Permits and Zoning report –
 - a. Dog complaint received by Gordon; he sent a letter concerning this issue.
9. Old Business:
 - a. Wireless Communication update
 1. The suggested ordinance was reviewed by the Planning Commission. **MOTION** (Ellenbecker/Schulteis) that the Town Board schedules a public hearing on this matter.
 - b. Amended Conditional Use Permit for Schram; no additional action needed; this was discussed in September. Chairman, Supervisors and Clerk will sign amended CUP and forward on to Schrams’.
10. New Business
 - a. Certified Survey Map for Ruth Kern. Gordon Hoffmann reviewed it. **MOTION** (Etta/Hesprich) to recommend to the town board that the Certified Survey Map be approved. Motion carried.
 - b. Site Plan for Jake’s Service was reviewed. The building is for storage. **MOTION** (Ellenbecker/Schulteis) to recommend that the town board approves this plan. Motion carried.
 - c. Preliminary plan for Carl Hohlweck’s land division was reviewed. A formal Certified Survey Map will need to be brought to the Planning Commission before any action is taken.
 - d. Discussion concerning rifle hunting took place. Addison is shotgun only. No action taken by the Planning Commission; we will follow DNR this year and see how things go with the hunting season.
 - e. Shoreland zoning – Planning Commission discussed this information from the attorney; no action taken at this time.
11. Visitors Comments/Concerns:
 - a. Brian Oelhafen voiced his support for rifle hunting in the town. Hunters can be careless regardless of the weapon used. Steve Schmitt affirmed this statement.
