

Kohlsville Pond Information

Last spring, the Kohlsville pond was drained to repair the dam on Main street and also the dam at the back pond. At that time it was discovered that the pond was only 2-3 feet deep, and is now in need of dredging. The pond is very important to the community as it is a huge water source for the Fire Department.

After close to 6 months of working with the DNR, the permit will be issued sometime in May to do the dredging. It is our hope that the digging can be done in July/ August if it dries up enough. If it does not dry up enough, it will have to be done next winter when there is frost in the ground.

This project is expected to cost in the area of \$140,000, of which approximately \$100,000 is available to date.

Any and all donations are welcome to help pay for the remainder of the cost of the project. There is a savings account set up at Westbury Bank where all donations will be deposited into, and will be paid directly to the contractor.
