 - a. Washington County Sheriff's Report - no one present
 - b. Town Maintenance
 - i. Bridges - Beechnut will start on 8/27 and West Bend Road on 8/31. Pfeiffer Brothers will put up message boards. Notified Johnson Bus, Lomira Schools of road closure. Will let Slinger Schools know also. Projected completion date is 10/30/26.
 - ii. On Saturday, 8/22, KFD will put in a new dry hydrant in the back pond.

He experiences a high volume of traffic when there is an accident on 41 and they close the road by Hwy 28 or Hwy D. This puts a lot of stress on this road. There is nothing that the Board can do. They can recommend that county roads are used as much as possible. Speed is a sheriff department issue. Right turns are used for safety reasons so the semis are not crossing traffic.
